Scope

SPECIFICATIONS FOR NON-INSTRUMENTED DRUG TESTING DEVICES (NIDTs) UNITED STATES PROBATION OFFICE EASTERN DISTRICT OF TEXAS

I. Device

The NIDT (Test Cup) must be capable of testing 10 drugs of abuse (AMP, MET, COC, THC, MDMA, OXY, OPI, BZO, FYL, and 6-Acetylmorphine) with adulterants of SG (specific gravity) pH, and creatinine simultaneously.
